First attempt. Daisy must complete the Fairy Quest to earn her wings. She creates a locket full of supplies to help her on her Quest.

Why doesn't it work? How do things get worse? Even though she feels she is ready she still has to wait until the Queen decides she is ready for the Quest. Daisy is impatient to begin.

Second attempt. The Quest begins. There are many challenges.

Why doesn't it work? How do things get worse? Each time Daisy completes one challenge a new, more difficult challenge begins.

Third attempt. It looks like they will solve their problem. Daisy completes the final challenge. She gains the gum tree pollen and all that is left is to find her way to the Fairy Queen before the moon rises.

What goes wrong? Being kind, Daisy gives away the gum tree pollen and then realises that the moon has risen.

Things get really bad. It looks like all is lost. Daisy has failed her Quest and has no magic left even to light her way back. She is lost at night in the forest.
